


Limited Primitive Camping (No Groups) is now available at Eastatoe Creek Heritage Preserve

Primitive camping (no campfires) is open in a **designated area only** at Eastatoe Creek Heritage Preserve. There is enough space for approximately 3 campsites. No group camping is available yet. Camp behind the Primitive camping signs. A map style sign is posted along the trail about 300 yards off of Horsepasture Road; that sign features the map below and three sliding signs for visitors to use. If the sign indicates a vacancy and you plan to camp please slide the sign to indicate an “occupied” site. All camping is on a first-come basis; **we do not reserve campsites**. When you leave from camping, slide sign position to “vacant.” Be thoughtful of others. **Do not** linger in areas with many standing dead hemlock snags. Do not camp outside of the designated area and no campfires are allowed.

Any evidence of illegal camping outside the designated area will result in closure of all camping on this preserve.
