

Botany Bay Plantation WMA Visitor Information

- 1. Please follow the Regulations.**
- 2. There are NO RESTROOMS-they are available at Edisto Beach State Park.**
- 3. There are no trash receptacles-please take your trash with you.**
- 4. The walk on the causeway to the beach is a half mile-one way. The causeway is suitable for wheelchairs. During the summer take plenty of water for the walk. Dogs are not allowed on the beach or the causeway to the beach.**
- 5. We do not provide transportation to the beach-no golf cart, no ATV's-you must walk!**
- 6. At low tide on the beach, there are areas of pluff mud called marsh relics-they are very slippery, and full of oyster shells. So PLEASE do not try to walk on them. People have been injured doing so.**
- 7. We do not recommend swimming-the rip currents are very dangerous, and there are lots of oyster shells and debris in the water.**
- 8. Please DO NOT DISTURB the nesting birds at the roped off areas of the beach. We would prefer that you don't even walk near the areas!!**
- 9. Regulations prohibit the taking of shells, fossils, bricks, or other artifacts, help keep this beach as wild and natural as possible.**
- 10. Alcohol is prohibited.**
